Metropolitan School Frankfurt was founded in 2007 as a private not-for-profit international school serving international and local families. MSF has graduated five classes, a total of 129 students.

Student Nationalities

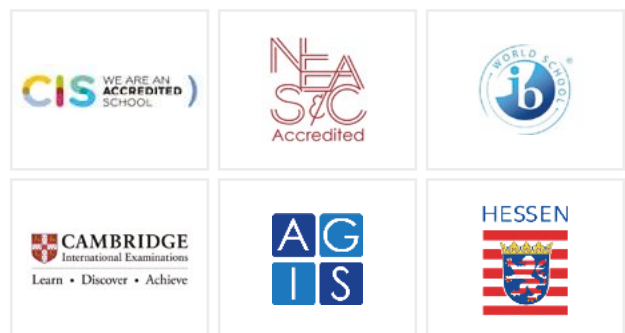
55 nationalities are represented in total, with 66% of our students having an international background.

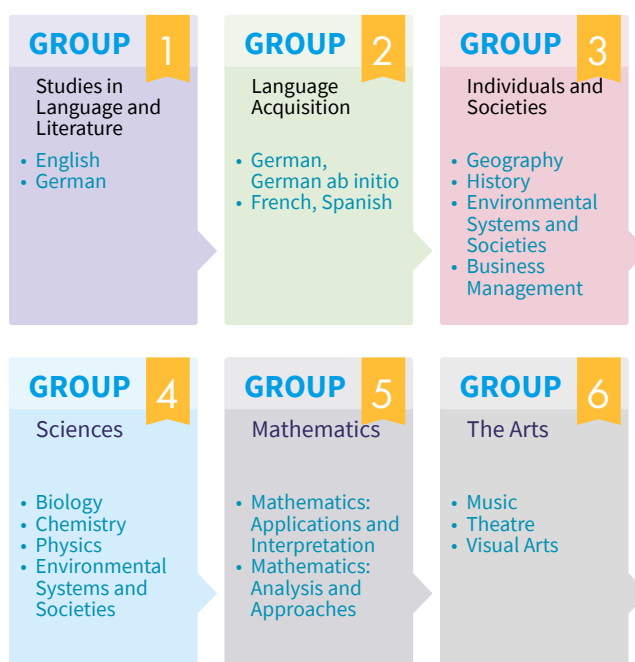

Curriculum Overview

Our programme consists of Grades 6 through 12. Students in Grades 6 – 10 are taught the Cambridge International Examination IGCSE curriculum and are prepared for the IGCSE examinations in Grades 9 and 10. These examinations provide a sound basis for the IB Diploma, a globally recognised university entrance qualification.

The IGCSE covers key elements of the relevant German Sekundarstufe I and II. Successful completion of the IGCSE examinations is considered by Hesse as equivalent to the Realschulabschluss.

The IB Diploma Programme (DP) is a challenging two-year curriculum, taught in Grades 11 and 12, leading to a widely recognized university entrance qualification that the world's leading universities value. The DP curriculum is built upon six subject groups together with the "DP Core" made up of three separate parts, CAS (Creativity, Action, Service), ToK (Theory of Knowledge) and EE (Extended Essay), each integrated with a range of approaches to learning.

Students select one subject from each of the six subject groups. Three are studied at Higher Level and the remaining three are studied at Standard Level. At the end of the programme, candidates are assessed both internally and externally in each subject.

The IB Diploma covers key elements of the German Sekundarstufe II and are considered as equivalent to Abitur. This equivalence is subject to certain criteria being fulfilled regarding specific course selection.

As a NEASC certified school, all students also earn an American High School Diploma.

Metropolitan School Frankfurt is exceptional. It is warm and welcoming. It provides an excellent international education to more than 690 students from 55 countries while maintaining a family-like atmosphere. Large enough to offer a wide selection of teaching and learning opportunities, MSF is small enough to feel like home.

Students pass the Diploma Programme by collecting a minimum of 24 points and a maximum of 45 points, as an accumulation of obtaining a numerical grade from 1–7 for each individual subject. The scale of assessment is set with 7 as the highest level of achievement and 1 as the lowest level of achievement. 3 additional points are awarded for successful completion of the Extended Essay and Theory of Knowledge.

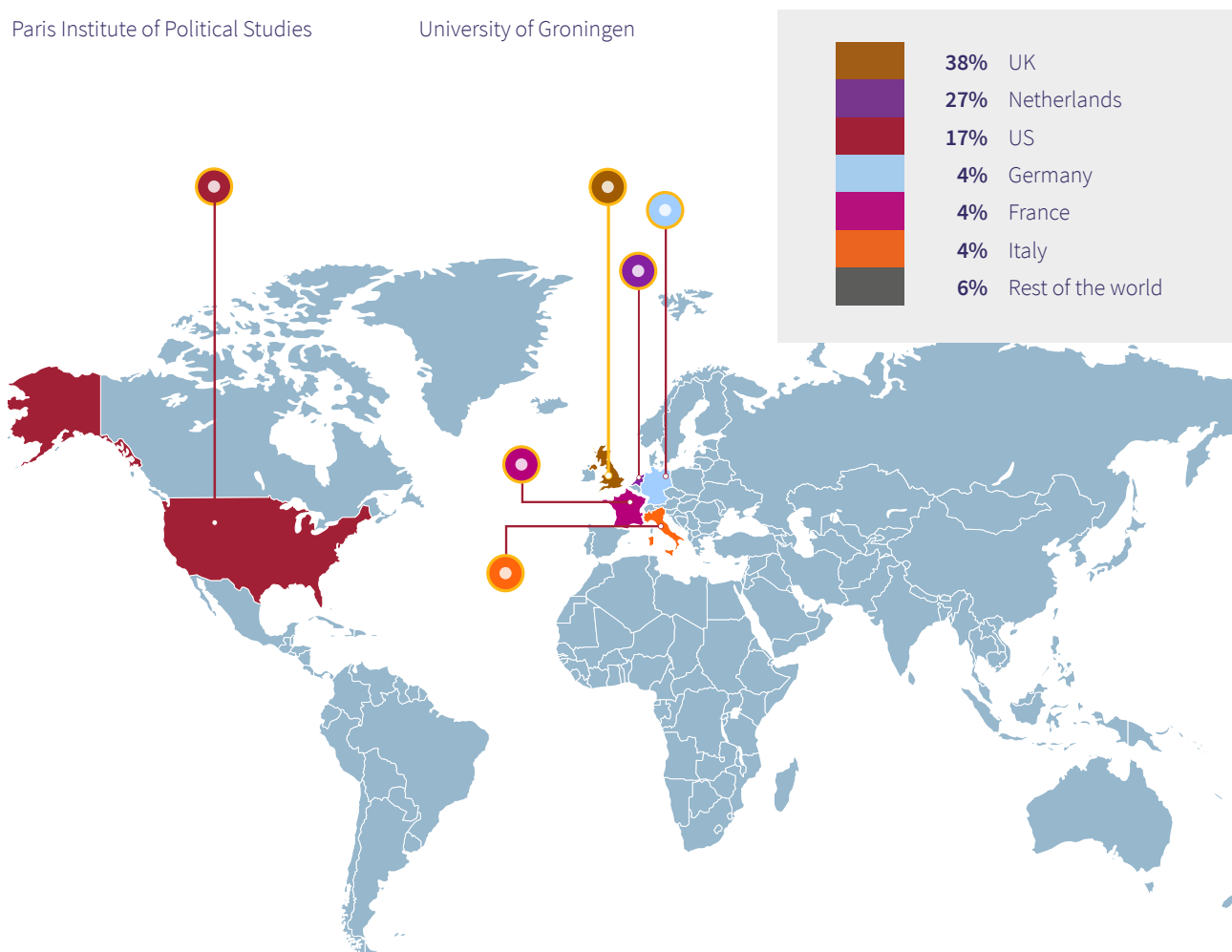
