#### Message from Mr Wragg

As part of an international community, we are very fortunate to have the chance to learn, work and socialise with people from all over the world. As an international school and part of the Association of German International Schools (AGIS), we are able to widen this community even further. We have two great examples of how we make the most of these opportunities, taking place this week. On Tuesday we hosted a cross country running event for our grade 3,4 and 5 students, competing against the International School of Frankfurt (ISF). This is the fourth sport that we have competed in, as a primary school, this year, after basketball, soccer and touch rugby tournaments. On Saturday we are hosting the first ever AGIS Young Leaders Conference. Berlin International School, Thuringia International School and the International School Bonn are all sending student delegates to meet and collaborate with representatives from our grade 4 & 5 student council. Leigh Kruger has organised this as part of her role as Student Leadership Coordinator and it promises to be an incredibly unique and special experience for our students, further emphasising our core value of caring through action.

#### Primary Student Council's "Caring through Action" Initiative

At the start of the school year, the Primary Student Council embarked on a compassionate campaign centred around taking action. They carefully selected Kinderhilfe, a charity based in Germany, as their chosen cause. Kinderhilfe focuses on providing care for children battling cancer and supporting their families both emotionally and physically. For a span of two weeks in May, Student Council members from Grades 2 to 5 organised a variety of engaging activities to raise funds. The activities included a sponsored lap run, a raffle featuring sweet-filled jars, a dream catching workshop, and a chalk drawing competition. Many students eagerly participated, contributing to the overall success of the campaign. Together, we managed to raise an impressive sum of over 1466 Euros. To ensure the funds reached Kinderhilfe, core committee members of the Student Council arranged a virtual meeting over Zoom. During this meeting, a representative from the charity expressed their gratitude and explained how the donation would be utilised. It was an interactive session where students also shared their own ideas on fundraising. None of this would have been achievable without the unwavering support of our parents and the enthusiastic participation of our students, particularly in the lap running sponsorships. Through initiatives like this, we witness the incredible

power of our school community coming together to care for one another.
